Update on rules and guidelines:

- 1. If you need to change days/times or cancel after the term starts, there will be a \$10 fee.
- 2. Children are advised not to swim/play in the pool BEFORE their lessons. This is to avoid students being late for their lessons or coming to the lesson in 'play mode' and not focusing. They are welcome to a swim afterwards.

Exceptions to this rule: If a parent is supervising the child playing and can make sure they are at their lesson on time or if a sibling is in a lesson before them.

We do not want this to be a punitive rule; we just want to ensure that the students are getting the most from their lessons.

Cost: \$15 for one session or \$25 for 2 sessions






Pink Shirt Day

Diaper Dolphin Reminders

- Please have children ready and waiting a couple of minutes before the lesson starts, with their: Hair tied back, goggles ready and have been to the toilet.
- Please encourage and remind your children they should only enter the water when they have been invited by either the tutor or their parent e.g. "Ok, Mummy is ready, you can get in now".
 - This should be used in all water environments, such as the pool, bath, paddling pool etc.
