This is an application by Stephen Murray Winter for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as "Brunner Workingmen's Club", Dobson.

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector outlines in her report the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested the applicant's understanding of his responsibilities as a manager. She does not oppose the application.

The Brunner Workingmen's Club treasurer provided a reference for the applicant, and she is supportive of his application.

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the granting of the application.

DECISION
