This is an application by Caroline Rose Mardon for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as the "Blackball Inn and '08 Cafe", Blackball

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and is the leasee of the Blackball Inn and '08 Cafe which has a current on-licence.

The Licensing Inspector outlines in her report the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested the applicant's understanding of her responsibilities as a manager. She does not oppose the application.

The applicant was the previous holder of a managers certificate which expired in January 2024.

The owners of the Blackball Inn and '08 Cafe are supportive of her application.

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the granting of the application.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.
