

Decision No. GREYDLC 119/2024

**IN THE MATTER**

of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

**AND**

**IN THE MATTER**

of an application by **KIMBLE UPFOLD AND BRIAN FORREST** pursuant to s.138 of the Act for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 421 Taylorville Road, Coal Creek and known as "Greymouth Clay Target Club"

**BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

Kimble Upfold and Brain Forrest have made an application for a special licence to sell and supply alcohol for three events at 421 Taylorville Road, Coal Creek and known as "Greymouth Clay Target Club".

The events are target shooting competitions. There is an estimated number of less than 100 people attending, with a probable age distribution of 18-85 years.

The proposed days and hours applied for are:

The premise's principal entrance is from the driveway of 421 Taylorville Road, Coal Creek.

The clubrooms, outdoor covered deck and ramp area and the clearly defined outside fenced area of the premises is designated as Supervised, as per the plan submitted with the application.

**DECISION**

The Grey District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Kimble Upfold and Brian Forrest for an on-site Special Licence for premises at 421 Taylorville Road, Coal Creek and known as "Greymouth Clay Target Club", subject to the following conditions:

**CONDITIONS**

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days during the following hours:

Friday 24th January, Saturday 25th January and Sunday 26th January 2025	The West Coast Classic	3.00pm to 8.00pm

2. The clubrooms, outdoor covered deck and ramp area and the outside fenced area of the premises is designated Supervised for the licence period and is shown on the plan attached to this licence.

3. A certified duty manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - Minors and intoxicated persons must not be served alcohol.
5. The licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. A sign at each principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by patrons, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol;
  - b. At every point of sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises and;
  - d. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
6. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic beverages.
7. Food, as listed by the applicant must be available for consumption on the premises during the licence hours.
8. Drinking water is to be provided free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
9. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
10. Noise levels are to be monitored at all times.
11. Payment of the fee prescribed under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013.

**The premises licensed area is set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 18 September 2024. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.**

### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant, Kimble Upfold, has a current manager's certificate and is an experienced manager.

The applicant's have provided in their application host responsibility details which demonstrate that suitable measures will be undertaken to provide the following measures with regard to the responsible sales or supply of alcohol, and that harm will be minimised by:

- Food, provided by a food truck with items as per the attached menu, will be available on the premises during the licence hours.
- Free bottled water will be available at the bar at no charge throughout the event.
- Non-alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages will be available.
- Signage displaying the taxi's phone number will be available to patrons.

The outside fenced area will be one metre high post and rail fencing and is clearly defined on the site plan attached to this application.

The applicant's have advised the Licensing Inspector that no alcohol will be available until shooting is finished and all firearms are secured for the day. This complies with the Arms Act 1983 and Firearms Safety Code, and the New Zealand Clay Target Association's requirements.

The Inspector's report indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent and that the applicant is suitable to hold this licence. She does not oppose this application.

The Police and the Medical Officer of Health raise no matters in opposition.

The application was not required to be publicly notified and no opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

Section 149(2) notes if a special licence issued is postponed to some other day, the licence is in force on the day on which the event or part takes place.

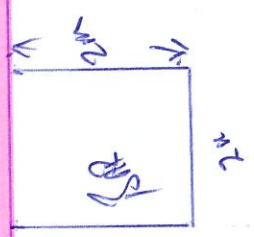
