

**MINUTE NO. 9 – DIRECTIONS TO BRING THE HEARING
TO A COMPLETION**

Dated 29 February 2024

- 1 We have considered an appropriate timetable that would apply once the actions addressed in our Minute 8 and Ms Booker's Memorandum of 28 February 2024 have occurred. To summarise, those actions are:
 - (a) Mr Geddes is to circulate a Memorandum on or before the end of Monday, 4 March 2024, that addresses the questions set out in paragraphs 9(a) to 9(c) of Minute 8; and
 - (b) Ms Booker is to provide further information on lighting and GHG emissions on or before the end of Friday, 8 March 2024.
- 2 We are mindful of the need to keep proceedings progressing, whilst also allowing enough time for the remaining participants to properly assess the available information and report back to us.
- 3 Consequently, we propose the following sequence of events and associated timetable:
 - (a) Should the Department of Conservation, Dr Susan Waugh (at the instruction of the CRRG) or Mr Stuart-Menteath wish to comment on the information that Ms Booker will provide on or before Friday, 8 March 2024, then any additional evidence or submissions to be provided in writing to Rasela Barrow on or before 5 pm on Friday 15 March 2024;
 - (b) End of hearing reports from Mr Harding, Mr Geddes and Dr Durand are to be provided in writing to Rasela Barrow on or before 5 pm on 20 Wednesday March 2024; and
 - (c) We will conduct an AVL hearing concerning items (b) and (c) on 20 March 2024 and will tell Rasela Barrow who is required, but any person making a contribution should plan to be available.
 - (d) The Reply submissions and any reply evidence from TIGA is to be provided in writing to Rasela Barrow on or before 5 pm on Monday, 26 March 2024.
 - (e) We will conduct an AVL hearing on 28 March 2024, addressing the reply submissions and evidence.

- 4 If any of the parties listed in paragraph 3 above have any concerns regarding the reasonableness of the proposed timetable, then we ask that they convey those concerns to Rasela Barrow within 48 hours.
