

**MINUTE NO. 10 – AMENDED TIMETABLE TO BRING THE HEARING
TO A COMPLETION**

Dated 4 March 2024

1 Following consultation we have amended 3(b) – (c) of Minute 9 in the manner underlined below so [3] of Minute 9 is amended as follows:

- (a) Should the Department of Conservation, Dr Susan Waugh (at the instruction of the CRRG) or Mr Stuart-Menteath wish to comment on the information that Ms Booker will provide on or before Friday, 8 March 2024, then any additional evidence or submissions are to be provided in writing to Rasela Barrow on or before 5 pm on Friday, 15 March 2024.
- (b) End of hearing reports from Mr Harding, Mr Geddes and Dr Durand are to be provided in writing to Rasela Barrow on or before 5 pm on 18 Monday, March 2024.
- (c) We will conduct an AVL hearing concerning items (a) and (b) on Wednesday 20 March 2024 commencing at 8.30 am ¹ and the Panel will advise Ms Barrow who is required but any person contributing should plan to be available and can request time even if we do not require their attendance. This session will include addressing any reply evidence from Ms MacKenzie on conditions which must be supplied by midday on the 19th of March 2024.²
- (d) The reply submissions and any reply evidence from TIGA are to be provided in writing to Rasela Barrow on or before 5 pm on Tuesday, 26 March 2024.
- (e) We will conduct an AVL hearing on Thursday, 28 March 2024, addressing the reply submissions and evidence.
