As a resident of over 50 years at Golden Sands Road, Barrytown, I wish to object strongly to any such mining activity, in or on our heritage coastal strip.

This is such a bad idea in many respects. The excessive movements of trucking to and from any such mining site will be extremely dangerous, as it will destroy the surface of our "Heritage " highway and be extremely costly to repair. It will be a hazard for all traffic on a particularly windy coastal road, which is subject to rock falls and heavy tourist traffic in the summer months. It will be noisy and create excessive diesel fumes that are contrary to the current Govt carbon emission responsibilities of less rather than more. It will be detrimental to the current rising tidal erosion that is occuring everywhere along our coastal lowland areas. 
