The Coast provides a quiet, natural environment, and affords immersion in nature, mindfulness and simple living This inspires reflection and gratitude for our forefathers and their honest and true values. My children and grandchildren visit regularly and their appreciation and connectivity is enhanced. *The West Coast is an environment so rare and it's original native characteristics should be protected as a cultural heritage. I appose the application due to the adverse effects of heavy trucking on our State Highway, on its users, on community wellbeing and on the environment: * The Coast Road would become an Industrial Rd and the impact on those communities would be increased stress, sleep deprivation and anxiety from regular Trucking noise. * Safety concerns for residents, cyclists, young children is a paramount concern as there is very limited ability to see Trucks approaching. The Road is narrowand windy, and the access off road reduced. There is limited visibility both ways and there would be little time or space to avoid trucks. * Adverse effects on infrastructure could cause instability of the high cliffs opposite the property and also the fractured vertical cliff on the seaward side of the road, causing a potention landslide.
