(1) The internationally important population of Westland Petrel/Taiko would be faced with damaging light distraction threats due to the proposed mining and trucking during the hours of darkness. Their slow reproductive rate combined with a population already severely damaged by recent weather events would very likely lead to significant negative effects upon the remaining numbers. (2) The increased heavy truck traffic brings significant risk to both local people and tourists using SH6 which is likely to face damage and repair costs which do not justify the benefits of this mining operation.
