In Australia I witnessed first hand the disregard of environment, historical /cultural sites and national endangered wild life by mining companies. I am personnally horrified that this may happen to this special environment in and around Barrytown in this age of awareness. Regularly on the beach I see penguins and seals along with tourists!! Tourism the source of many locals income! To introduce an industry to an environment that does not seem compatible to its existing nature and livelihood feels like we are again going backwards. I am very concerned about the noise pollution and increase in heavy vehicles on a road already vulnerable to weather and geology. With the mountains rising high so close to the road, this creates a natural amphitheatre, the noise lifts in volume and directly affects all who live along the coast road. With trucks running 5am10pm 7 days a week, this will affect residents sleep, sense of peace and mental health. Being a resident that travels the Coast Road several times a week, I see camper vans, tourists biking and locals biking all who again are extraordinarily vulnerable on this road. To add more heavy vehicles to this road, it seems inevitably it will invite a tragic outcome.
