I can confirm that Councils intention is to change the Richmond Quay road space in front of the proposed Library building, to stop the road or to change its status as a shared space without through traffic. Our intention is to close off the East end at Boundary Street to traffic, with limited access for service vehicles to what is currently boundary Street from the west end. What is currently Boundary street will become landscaped public realm for pedestrians, gathering, with seating, planting, and space for events and not include a vehicle carriageway.


These changes will require a low level of public consultation and a Council resolution.
